

If you PICK IT, you MUST PAY for it if you have not already. You may see something ready on on the list, after paying at check in... that's ok. Just notify the cashier.

We have no parking or entry fees. Stay as long as you like. Prices are non negotiable regardless of size, etc.

Not all crops listed available at all times! ASK DRIVER before you pick!

GARWOOD U-PICK RULES

- 1.** If you **PICK IT**, you **MUST PAY** for it. Don't hide things on the wagon or on the farm or in your purse or kids stroller. Our produce sniffing dogs will find it.
- 2.** **TRY ONE.** We allow sampling. We are not a smorgasbord. You will be weighed upon entry and exit. No really, enjoy sampling. Remember that apples, even on the same tree do not ripen at the same time. If we are not picking a variety you like, it is not ready yet. **NO PICKING POLES/DEVICES ALLOWED.**
- 3.** Prices are non-negotiable. Don't ask if the fingernail sized pepper you picked is free. It isn't. Don't pick it. It wants to grow up to be a pepper. Wouldn't you like to be a pepper, too? That sounds like a slogan. **PICK CAREFULLY** and show respect for our farm. **DON'T THROW THINGS ON THE GROUND.** Increased apples and produce on the ground, mean increased prices. **CAREFULLY** twist & pull fruit - see #4.
- 4.** Don't climb, shake, or otherwise assault the trees. If you pull and tug on the apples you are hurting the trees and dropping the apples. Pick them up and put them in your bag to purchase. You've seen the Wizard of Oz trees? Ours can get angry. Be nice to them. They're watching you. Gently twist and pull apples to remove from the tree.
- 5.** No pets in vegetable or berry fields. The plants are allergic to them. Orchard areas and lanes are fine. **KEEP PETS LEASHED.** Unleashed pets will be confiscated and kept... we love pets. Note: Children are **NOT** allowed in the pickle patch (sounds silly but it's true, really - no kids or pets in the pickle patch).
- 6.** Stay seated on the wagons. You can wave your arms, you can sing, you can wiggle... but don't stand up and walk around. The ride can get bumpy and falling hurts.
- 7.** Don't throw things. (This means apples, peppers, pumpkins, knives.... this is not a carnival. It's a farm). Handle your items like eggs. Fruit bruises. You'll like your things better at home if you are gentle with them here. **NOTE: THROWING ANYTHING AT A WAGON (HORSE, TRACTOR, OR PERSON) RESULTS IN IMMEDIATE REMOVAL FROM OUR FARM.**
- 8.** **REFRIGERATE** your items at home. Apples like 38 degrees. Don't call us in two weeks to say your apples look bad after you left them on your porch, basement, or creepy bunker.
- 9.** Pick up after yourself. We have trash cans. You have common sense. Use both.
- 10.** **ABSOLUTELY NO WALKING DOWN MAIN ROAD FROM MARKET/UPICK.** Our main roadway is highly traveled. It's the country, yes... but we have real motorized cars here too! For liability reasons you are required to park at the market for the market and drive to and park at the upick for the upick. **DO NOT WALK THE ROADWAY.**
- 11.** **HAVE FUN!** This is the most important rule. **FUN** is good. Our family loves this farm and we take pride in keeping it in top condition and growing a wide variety of fruits and vegetables. We want you to love our farm too, for generations to come! Tell your friends about us and tag us in your social media pics!
